Who are we looking for?

What would your role be?

- **Full-day English communication:** Speaking with students in English even outside of formal English lessons.
- **Continuous classroom presence:** Being present in the classroom throughout the school day and collaborating with the lead guides on lesson planning and preparation.
- **Assistance and Support:** When formal language teaching is not taking place, you act as a teaching assistant.
- **Practical help:** You assist with preparing educational materials, lead small groups of children, or support students with special educational needs.

- **Versatility:** Your work is very diverse – one moment you are motivating children to speak English, the next you are helping with a project in another subject or supporting students in organizing a school event.

What we expect from you:

- Experience in teaching English, a degree in languages or a relevant certificate (minimum C1 level).
- Ability to work in English throughout the entire day.
- Empathy and patience when working with children.
- Excellent communication and teamwork skills.
- Willingness to adapt to the changing needs of children and a deep respect for individual learning styles.
- Basic knowledge of Montessori philosophy is an advantage.
- Additional teaching qualifications are a plus.
